Dear Parents, Carers and Pupils of Class 4,

I cannot believe that Term 6 has come around already! I hope that you have had a fantastic break over the half term and that the class are ready for another fantastic term of learning. The Class Four teaching team continues to include myself, Mrs McLanaghan, Miss Mason and Mr Luck.

In English this term the children will be planning and writing their own formal letters. They will be working hard to include the features of this text type, for example by including formal language and a range of conjunctions to help their ideas to flow cohesively. The children will then move on to descriptive writing where they will be building a bank of rich and varied vocabulary to really bring their writing to life!



Our first maths unit this term includes learning about statistics. The children will be learning how to interpret a range of charts and they will be solving comparison, sum and difference problems. The children will also be learning how to present data on a line graph. Our final maths unit this term will be Geometry. The class will be exploring the properties of shapes as well as their position and direction.



This term in Science we will be finishing our topic about living things. The children will be creating their own classification keys which could be used to identify a range of species in a particular habitat. We will then be completing a range of experiments to develop our investigative and 'working scientifically' skills.

In our Topic this term, the children will be learning about a range of local fieldwork skills. The children will be exploring and creating their own maps, using different symbols to represent key locations and amenities. Within their learning, the children will have the opportunity to develop their orienteering skills using maps and compasses. In Art, the children will be completing some observational sketches. They will be encouraged to use different media, such as printing and water colour, to add colour and dimension to their artwork.

Within their RE learning, Class Four are going to be exploring why some people might think of life as a journey. The children will be considering a range of significant life events that could be seen as milestones in someone's life and they will think about why these milestones may be important to Christians, Hindus and Humanists.

In PSHCE, the children will be exploring how we are growing and changing. The class will be learning about what happens to us when we grow up and how people's emotions can change as we get older.

In French the children will be learning about the vocabulary for classroom objects and they will be comparing the school day in England and France. Within their computing learning, Class Four will be learning how to create their own Stop Frame Animation film. The children will enjoy creating their own characters to star in their stop frame animations! In music the children will be exploring music from different time periods in their music lessons. The children
