# School Improvement Plan

We have FIVE main areas to our school improvement plans this year. They are:

- **Continuing to improve the outcomes for all our children**
- **Further improving the quality of teaching, learning and assessment across the school**
- **Ensuring high quality personal development, behaviour and welfare for all**
- **Focusing on aspects of whole school provision and leadership**
- **Further developing the Christian distinctiveness of the school.**

## IMPROVING THE OUTCOMES FOR ALL OF OUR CHILDREN

What does this mean?

We want to increase the proportion of pupils who make more than expected progress, especially middle-attaining pupils, so that even more pupils achieve greater depth by the end of each key stage in all subjects, this includes Early Years, Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2.

We are aiming to maintain and improve our high key stage 2 results from this year, particularly Greater Depth in maths.

We are aiming to maintain our above national expectations at the end of Key Stage 1, including the year 1 phonics check.

We aim to increase educational success or attainment that extends beyond exams to social, artistic, musical, sporting and leadership endeavours by formalising our Curriculum offer. This means that every child will be aware of what they will experience by the time they leave Selling Primary School and every child has an opportunity to explore their talents.

## ENSURING HIGH QUALITY PERSONAL DEVELOPMENT, BEHAVIOUR AND WELFARE FOR ALL

What does this mean?

For the next two years we have signed up to take part in the **Achievement for All Programme**. This is an exciting project to raise the educational aspirations, access and achievement for children resulting in positive impacts on their reading, writing, behaviour and attendance.

We aim to improve our whole school attendance from 96.1% by aiming to be above 97% this year. This would give us outstanding whole school attendance.

We aim to use the Growth Mindset model across the school to build children's resilience for failure and mistakes.

### What does this mean?

To further ensure that Teaching Assistants provide purposeful and effective interventions for identified pupils through ongoing identified training and rigorous monitoring for impact.

To ensure that all pupils are engaged and involved in their learning by using the Achievement for All Programme and Growth Mindset.

We aim to close any attainment gap, by developing more effective teaching for all children in their classroom and more effective and holistic provision mapping via the Achievement for All Programme.

## **FOCUSING ON ASPECTS OF WHOLE SCHOOL PROVISION AND LEADERSHIP**

### What does this mean?

Further developing the role of governors in monitoring and supporting the school's work.

Leaders fulfil their responsibilities as a lead for their subject area to provide continuous improvement.

To utilize school website to attract and advertise the work within the school.

To consolidate, support and develop a culture of distributed, inclusive and effective leadership throughout the school community.

## **FURTHER DEVELOPING THE CHRISTIAN DISTINCTIVENESS OF THE SCHOOL**

### What does this mean?

By July 2019, our aim is to ensure that pupils are developing their religious literacy by following the Understanding Christianity scheme of work across the school.

Pupils will be taking greater ownership of Collective Worship through the development of a Christian Ethos team.

Our whole school vision will be adapted in order to reflect the importance of being a Church of England school.
